

Course Name: Practicum in Criminal Justice

Catalog description:

Supervised placement with a criminal justice agency to allow the student the opportunity to explore career choices while gaining actual job experience in the criminal justice field. Students will be required to participate a minimum of eight hours per week (120 hours per semester) and to attend a bi-weekly meeting with the Practicum advisor.

Prerequisite: CJS*E101 – Introduction to Criminal Justice; CJS*E201 – Criminology; CJS*E211 – Criminal Law; CJS*E213 – Evidence and Criminal Procedure; CJS*E259 – Writing and Research for Law Enforcement, **and** permission of the Program Coordinator.
